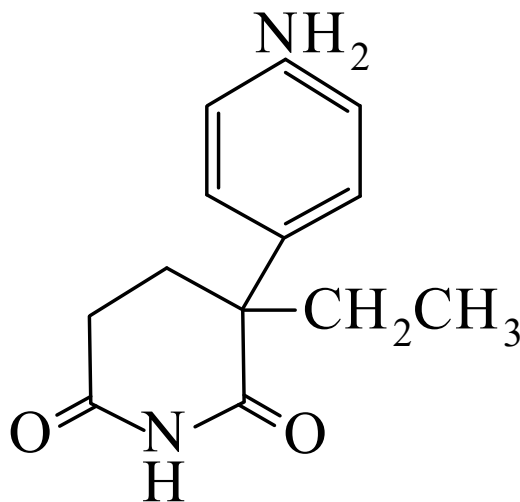

Biological Use/Importance: Originally used as anticonvulsant, withdrawn due to adrenotoxicity: now used as aromatase inhibitor for treatment of breast cancer in postmenopausal women and for treatment of secondary hyperaldosteronism and oedema. Inhibits adrenal corticosteroid synthesis

Hazard & Toxicity: Human teratogenic effects. LD₅₀ (mus, ipr) 625 mg/kg
