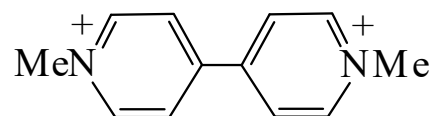

Hazard & Toxicity: OES: long-term 0.1 mg m⁻³ (respirable dust). Conc. commercial formulations irritate skin, eyes and mucous membranes, and can injure eyes by direct contact. Many fatalities are associated with ingestion of 20% w/v solns., with death delayed for up to 2-3 weeks. Effects of ingestion incl. oesophageal ulceration, severe gastrointestinal effects, and damage to kidneys, liver, lungs and pancreas. The lung is a particular target organ for paraquat. LD₅₀ (rat, orl) 57 mg/kg. LD₅₀ (rat, skn) 80 mg/kg. Exp. reprod. and teratogenic effects
