Use/Importance: Synthetic reagent of great utility and historical importance. Acetals with ethylene and propylene glycols are used in perfumery. Used as EtOH soln. as a metal indicator in titrimetry with EDTA of Fe(III) (pH range 1-2; colour change red-violet → pale yellow). Flavouring agent
