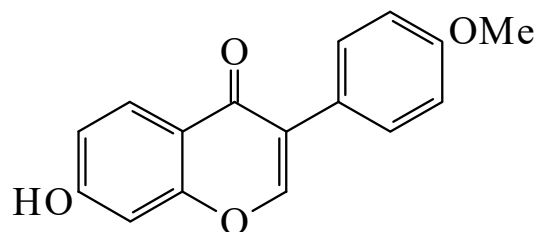

Found also in *Baptisia australis*. Widely distributed in the Leguminosae (Papilionoideae). Also in *Viola caducifolia* and *Viola multinervia* (Myricaceae)

Biological Use/Importance: Shows estrogenic props.
