Hazard & Toxicity: Symptoms from prolonged or repeated (occup.) exposure incl. nausea, headache, eye, skin and respiratory tract irritation. Can cause asthma and dermatitis. LD₅₀ (rat, orl) 134 mg/kg. OES: short-term 0.2 ppm
