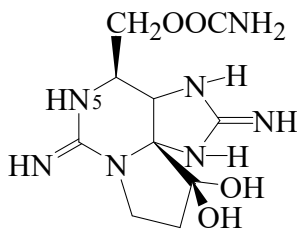

BERDY HAZD : LD₅₀ (mus, ipr) .01 mg/kg
