Use/Importance: Catalyses direct reaction between CO_2 and amino alcohols, diamines or secondary amines to give 2-oxazolidinones, 2-imidazolones or ureas; catalyses aminolysis of *N*-protected amino acids, leading to peptides; catalyst for oxirane polym; catalyses amine + acid $\rightarrow$ amide; catalyst for aminolysis of RCOSH with RNH_2 or $\text{R}_2\text{NH} \rightarrow \text{RCONHR}$ etc.; oxidises thiols
